GENERAL MEETING CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Town of Rhine Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Ron Platz at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, January 5, 2016 in the Town of Rhine Hall, W5250 CTH FF, Elkhart Lake, WI.

***PROCEEDINGS:**

1. **Compliance with Open Meeting Law:** The agenda was posted on January 3rd, 2016.
2. **Pledge.**
3. **Approve minutes of December 1, 2015:** Stand as written.
4. **Treasurer's Report:** Approved as presented.
5. **Building Permits for November:** Read into the record.
6. **Public Comments:** Paul Booher Little Elkhart Lake, are you going to post items on the boards at all like special notices. It was the opinion of the clerk/treasurer that anything other than Town Board and Committee meetings will be posted at the Collection site and Little Elkhart lake locations. Add to the next agenda Little Elkhart Lake representative from the Town Board.
7. ***Discuss and possibly act on:**
 - a. Dolezal – Deferred Prosecutoin Agreement – the chairman explained the agreement and where we are in the process right now. The court fines and fees will be paid by the Dolezal's.
 - b. Spring Election update – the clerk/ treasurer gave information on the two candidates Todd Purkey for Supervisor #3 and Frank Zimmermann for Supervisor #4. There were no other papers turned in as of the deadline on 1/5/16 at 5 p.m.
 - c. Orange Cross Ambulance – they will be invited to give the reporting at an upcoming meeting.
 - d. WTA – membership – we will automatically renew memberships and possible hosting of a meeting here in the future.
8. **Chairman's information report:** Chairman Platz has not received any more information on the 2 other houses. (Schad and Faust properties) Attorney has been consulted about large animal operations over 501 animals. A conditional use permit must be obtained if you are over the 501 animal limit. He also consulted the attorney about land use around the lakes. Under new legislation the home owner's attorney stated they do not need to go through our variance process. We have not received clarification as of yet on these. Rost brought out the information that was in the WTA regarding the new lake state information. If the state changed this we should have been notified, this is why we are having our attorney look into this. There is a meeting tomorrow in Madison regarding Act 55.

9. **Sub-Committee reports:** LAKES AND SANITATION: Feld stated instituted permit requirement and everyone is happy with it. People want more permits for convenience. It seems like it is helping, there isn't quite as big a crowd out there as there normally is. The site attendants have also turned people away with large trailers with what looks like building materials because they should be getting a dumpster for these items. ROADS: Zimmermann noted that a liquid manure hauler damaged the road and the county has been repaired the damage and the hauler will be billed for the repair. He would like an ordinance in place for damage done to roads and possible permits for heavy hauling and regarding clean up. Snow removal clean up should be cited when snow is left on the road, the county had to go through some areas 3 times to clean up snow that was left behind from personal residences. Chairman Platz stated we should have an ordinance on the books and we will forward to the Ordinance committee to look at this. The weight and the volume on the roads we may see some issues in the future. Snow plowing everybody is complaining that their roads was last. In the summer months the county will put a black and white marker so the corners are not cut to short. The county has not been told what road to plow first, he will follow up to see what the process is.
